1. The following definitions apply in these terms and conditions:

Consultation:	a discussion between a User and a Consultant organised at the request of the User and with Our knowledge and agreement.
Consultant:	a person appointed and authorised by Us to hold a Consultation with a User.
Content:	any and all statements and information made or provided by a Consultant in or in connection with a Consultation.
Trade	the trade of business of retail sales of books and other publications to members of the public.
these Terms	these Terms and Conditions.
User:	any person, firm or corporation who carries on business in the Trade and who seeks or participates in a Consultation.
